Did You Know?

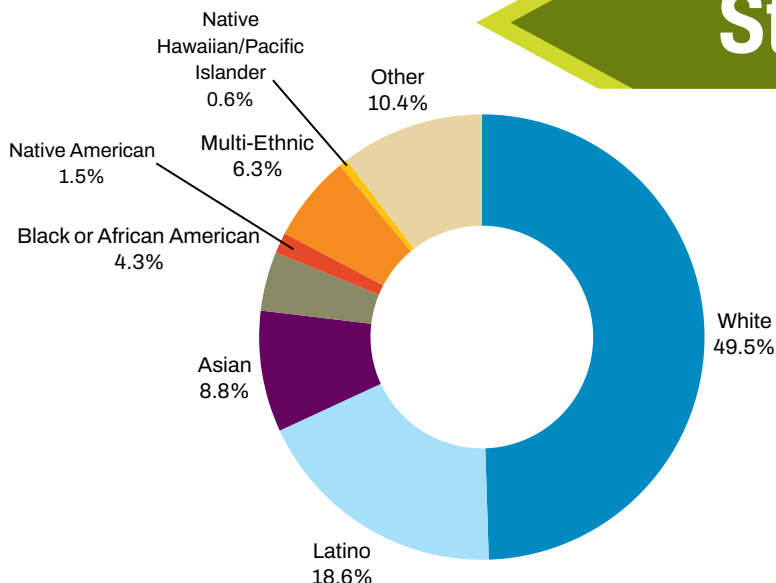
All PSU students must complete an experiential learning activity, such as a capstone project or internship, as part of their degree requirements.

Capstone is an academic course where interdisciplinary student teams work with community partners to tackle important local issues. The program aims to build a more just and equitable world while enhancing students' career readiness and their ability to articulate these skills to future employers.

An average of 40% of our students complete at least one internship per year.

Our degree programs equip students with the following career readiness competencies: Career & Self-Development, Leadership, Communication, Professionalism, Critical Thinking, Teamwork, Equity & Inclusion, Technology.
