### **Career Coaching & Services**

## **Top Five Goals**

- Increase engagement with 1:1 career coaching appointments and event attendance
- Embed career content into academic curriculum
  - The #1 way that students said they'd like to learn about career content and meet with employers is in the classroom
- Improve employment outcome rates for undergraduate and graduate students
- Provide more customized support to BIPOC, LGBTQIA+, first generation, and other historically underrepresented student communities
- Continue to connect students and employers in meaningful ways and to promote employer partner's jobs and internships to increase hiring rates



### **Impact Metrics**

- 100% of all senior, post-bacc, and graduate students have access to career services
- 85% of students who access career services are satisfied
- 36 career-related events hosted
- 90 companies recruiting on-campus
- 120 student and mentor matches

### **Upcoming Events & Programs**

- Career Conversation events that focus on identitybased career guidance, such as BIPOC, LGBTQIA+, and first generation college students
