The School of Business Career Center celebrated its one-year anniversary. The Career Center provides all business students with an innovative case management approach to career coaching. It is personalized and targeted to help students achieve their career goals. Each coach has a caseload of students based on their major and this allows students to receive customized guidance.

This guidance includes students receiving weekly/biweekly communication from their career coach with jobs/internships for their area of study, upcoming events, and tips/advice on career development needs for their major.

Coaches also have more knowledge about their major industries, which allows students to get focused support in their one-on-one coaching appointments. Coaches also visit key classes in their major to connect with students in the classroom because that's where they are most often engaged. Students have access to free business attire through the Clothing Closet located in the Karl Miller Center to use for interviewing or for their new job.
